

IQA Partnership Packages 2026/2027

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Answers to common questions about partnering with the IQA in 2026/2027.

Who can become a partner?

Partnerships are designed for three groups: suppliers of products or services to the sector, authorities such as regulators, governments and councils, and quarries. There are packages to suit each.

What levels are available, and what do they cost?

There are two levels, national and state. National Platinum partnerships cover all states and territories and start from \$15,000 +GST per year (two-year rate). State partnerships (Gold, Silver and Bronze) cover your chosen state or territory and start from \$1,200 +GST per year. Full pricing and the complete list of inclusions for each level are set out in the prospectus.

How long does a partnership run, and when does it start?

Partnerships run for either 12 or 24 months from the date of your contract.

How does payment work, especially for a two-year partnership?

Partnerships are invoiced annually. If you choose a two-year term, your discounted price is locked in now at this year's rates, and you are invoiced separately for each year of the partnership when that year begins. For example, you are invoiced on 1 July 2026 for the 2026 fees, with an automatic invoice following on 1 July 2027 for the 2027 fees.

When is payment due?

A confirmation invoice is issued once your partnership is accepted. Payment is due within 14 days of the invoice date. For a two-year partnership you are invoiced annually, as set out above.

Has the pricing changed for 2026/27?

Some levels carry a slightly higher headline annual price this year, but every package now delivers more value. State Gold, for example, gains unlimited job listings, complimentary memberships, IQA Quarry Directory inclusion and That's Solid campaign rights. Choosing the two-year option also locks in a lower annual rate, a saving of around 17 per cent on Gold, and locks in this year's pricing for two years.

I sponsored at National Gold or National Silver last year. What's the equivalent for 2026/27?

The national tiers have been simplified into a single National Platinum partnership, covering all states and territories. Inclusions are tailored to whether you partner as a supplier, an authority or a quarry.

On a two-year term it starts from \$15,000 +GST per year depending on partner type (one-year terms from \$18,000 +GST), and consolidates your national reach into a single package.

The full pricing and inclusions are set out in the prospectus.

What is the IQA Quarry Directory?

It is a new national directory of quarry operations introduced for 2026/27. All partners receive recognition in the directory, and Gold Quarry Partners receive a premium listing, giving your brand year-round visibility to the operators who use it. The directory is due to be released in late 2026 and will be updated annually.

I previously sponsored Women in Quarrying or the Young Member Network. Where have those packages gone?

Women in Quarrying and Young Member Network recognition and hosting opportunities are now built into a Gold partnership. Instead of backing a single program, you get that same involvement plus far broader year-round visibility across the IQA network, including a Quarry Directory listing, unlimited job postings, complimentary memberships, That's Solid campaign rights and a dedicated event spotlight. On a two-year term, Gold comes in at \$4,000 per year, locking in a lower annual rate while delivering considerably more reach than a standalone package.

There are also standalone one-off event sponsorship opportunities for Women in Quarrying and Young Member Network events, starting from \$1,500 per event if you would like a more specific focus.

Can I get a tailored package?

Yes. If none of the standard packages is quite the right fit, we can put together a tailored partnership to match your goals. Email sponsorship@quarry.com.au to discuss the options.

Can I sponsor a specific event, such as a golf day or conference?

Yes. Individual events, including branch golf days, state conferences and the National Conference, offer their own sponsorship opportunities separate from the annual partnership program. An IQA partnership includes complimentary tickets and recognition at many events, but to sponsor a particular event directly, contact the team at sponsorship@quarry.com.au to discuss what is available.
