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COURSE OVERVIEW

The **Electrical Awareness** workshop provides participants with an understanding of basic electrical principles and the identification of electrical hazards.

The course will cover:

- Relationship between legislation, standards, guidelines
- Competencies
- Supervision of electrical workers
- Contractor management
- Risk management relating to electrical installations
- Identification of electrical hazards
- Protective devices for electrical circuits
- Areas of high concern

Who should do the course?

This course is targeted at Quarry Managers, Quarry Supervisors, Senior managers / staff, H&S Officers.

Why attend?

There is significant focus on electrical awareness by state regulators. Quarry owners, managers and senior staff should understand their responsibilities and the relationship between legislation, standards, guidelines. The workshop will provide an understanding of the basic electrical principles and how to manage risk relating to electrical installations.
