Learning From Disasters Workshop

COURSE OVERVIEW

Learning from experience, preventing devastating reoccurrences and improving the health and safety of all those working in the quarrying and associated industries is essential in reducing the risk of serious injuries or fatalities.

The IQA is approved by the NSW Resources Regulator, to deliver the ‘Learning from Disasters’ one-day program. Under the Maintenance of Competence Scheme developed by the NSW Resources Regulator, for those holding a NSW Practising Certificate - Quarry Manager (without conditions) *a minimum of 90 hours professional development is required, over five (5) years. This includes completing the Regulator’s approved Learning from disasters one-day program.*

Learning Outcomes:

- Recognise recurrent patterns of failure linked to significant work health and safety incidents.
- Understand how identifying and managing a principal hazard links to reducing risk.
- Recognise the causal role human and organisational factors and critical factors play in work health and safety incidents.
- Build an understanding of roles, responsibilities and mechanisms that foster a safe work culture.
- Identify contemporary risk factors and vulnerabilities in your organisational safety management systems.
- Develop risk control options and strategies that best manage work, health and safety risks.

CPD hours: 7 hours - General Workplace Health and Safety. A completion certificate will be issued once finished.

Why attend?

To reflect on previous disasters and understand the essential factors for building a safety culture, identifying and controlling risks.

Delivery

Delivery is either via virtual training (through a platform such as Team or Zoom) or face to face. If being delivered virtually, all participants must have access to the internet and a laptop / tablet that can run Zoom.

MANDATORY CPD & QMCS

The Quarry Manager Certification System (QMCS) is a system implemented by the IQA for granting professional recognition to quarry industry professionals.

The system is designed to include:

- allocation of professional development hours (and category) for all IQA training and member involvement;
- requirements for ongoing professional development for the achievement and maintenance of Certified Practicing status;
- requirements for continuing practice in the industry for the maintenance of Certified Practicing status; and
- professional ethical standards to be adhered to by certified practicing quarry managers and supervisors.

Certified Practitioner Categories

The CP Committee may accredit persons as CPs in the categories that are approved from time to time by the CP Committee on the advice of the Board. The current Categories are:

- a) Certified Practicing Quarry Manager (CPQM)
- b) Certified Practicing Quarry Supervisor (CPQS)

The IQA has aligned the QMCS with the requirements for Quarry Managers holding a Certificate of Competency in NSW with the required **90 hours** of professional development over 5 years - as determined by the NSW Resources Regulator.
